2010 Fall ReLeaf Program The Cincinnati Park Board is giving away trees to city residents. The ReLeaf program aims to beautify city streets by planting 550 trees. Urban Forester Robin Hunt says the trees are supplied by local nurseries and are between six and eight feet tall. "We have given away little seedlings... but the idea by giving away containerized trees is that you've got a tree that's a little more durable," he says,

adding, "Several studies have shown that (planting a tree) can increase your property value anywhere from five to seven percent." Hunt says there are seven species from which to choose. To qualify, you must live within city limits and the planting location must be visible from the street but must not interfere with utilities. Applications must be submitted by September 24th and trees will be available for pick up in mid-October. The project is funded by a grant from Duke Energy.
